To all airline customers of Melbourne Airport (MEL)**Terms and Conditions of Use of Aeronautical Services and Facilities at Melbourne – Schedule of Charges update from 1 July 2025**

Australia Pacific Airports (Melbourne) Pty Ltd (**APAM**) notifies you of a change to the Schedule of Charges for airlines operating under the Terms and Conditions of Use of Aeronautical Services and Facilities at Melbourne Airport effective from 1 July 2025.

The proposed charges were outlined in a letter dated 4 April 2025, however, following completion of the industry consultation period and as a result of minor changes in forecast FY26 BBM parameters affecting passenger services, the charge for RPT services has been revised downwards for both the International and Domestic passenger services to \$34.38 and \$9.07 per passenger respectively.

There are no other changes to the Schedule of Charges and the charges set out below in Table 1 will come into effect on 1 July 2025.
