Environment Policy

Purpose

APAM is committed to reducing our environmental impact. The purpose of this policy is to set the direction for our Airport Environment Strategy to deliver this commitment.

Context

Our vision is to create an airport Melbourne can be proud of. As a vital piece of strategic infrastructure that benefits the national economy, Melbourne Airport facilitates tourism, freight and trade, and creates business and personal connections to the global marketplace.

Within this dynamic operating environment, APAM will work proactively with tenants, contactors and other stakeholders to implement the environmental management commitments below.

Our goal

To be an environmental leader for transport and logistics sites in the Asia Pacific region.

Our Commitments

As an environmentally responsible organisation, and to achieve our Environment Policy goal, the APAM Senior Leadership Team commits to providing the necessary focus and resources for our organisation to:

- be responsible for, and protect the environment directly and indirectly impacted by Melbourne Airport's operations
- continually improve our environmental performance through the use of our certified Environmental Management System
- make a material reduction in energy consumption and operational carbon emissions, and adopt measures to conserve natural resources and adapt to climate change
- minimise waste by implementing the waste hierarchy and adopting a lifecycle approach to procurement
- prevent, limit and reduce pollution where possible
- manage our landholdings to protect and enhance biodiversity and cultural heritage, while maintaining aircraft safety as a priority
- comply with all applicable environmental and energy laws, policies, procedures and other compliance obligations and, where appropriate, exceed these requirements
- work with our employees, tenants, business partners, regulators and local and regional communities to develop new strategies to improve environmental performance and protect the environment
- seek to strike a fair balance in identifying and delivering an appropriate and sustainable solution where there are trade-offs between different environmental and / or community impacts
- Make best use of our existing facilities and design, construct and operate new facilities in support of our environmental and sustainability goals.

This policy applies to all activities related to the management and operation of Melbourne Airport. This includes the activities of employees, tenants and contractors.
