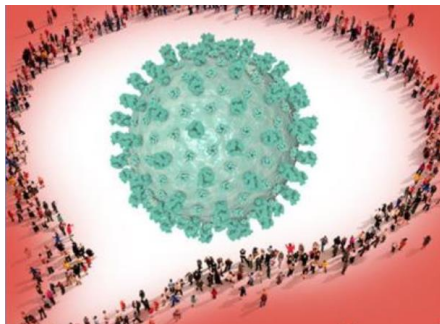


REPORTING OF COVID-19 CASES TO MELBOURNE AIRPORT



<p>ALERT SUMMARY</p>	<p>Melbourne Airport is reiterating to the airport community that health and safety issues need to be reported, which includes positive cases of COVID-19.</p> <p>As the organisation with management of the airport facility, Melbourne Airport needs to understand when and where positive cases of COVID-19 are occurring in and around the airport.</p> <p>This understanding allows Melbourne Airport to address risks of transmission in common areas, and share learnings with the airport community.</p>
<p>RISKS</p>	<p>COVID-19 poses a health and safety risk to all airport workers, public, and government agencies.</p> <p>The risk of transmission of COVID-19 at Melbourne Airport has the potential to disrupt operations, and could potentially result in closure of sections of the airport for a period of time.</p>
